The General Committee is working on keeping our church community safe in these uncertain times. We have a representative working with the community about Active Shooter Awareness and we are looking into how best to adapt this knowledge as it fits our church. There will be an Active Shooter Awareness meeting, Sat., Nov. 9th 8:30-10:00am at the Stephentown Memorial Library if you are interested. We are announcing the following at the beginning of each service:

"We are implementing a new procedure to protect our congregation. At the beginning of the service, the two outside doors into Pierce Hall are being locked for our protection. There is no problem for anyone to exit thru those doors at any time. Please feel free to use the entrance door by the pulpit if you need to use the facilities. If you enter Pierce Hall during the service using the lock code, please be sure to close the door upon entering and exiting. Be advised there are two doors to exit the sanctuary. The front door and the one by the pulpit into Pierce Hall. We are looking into other ways we can be proactive and keep us safe."

We have installed some additional insulation on the Pierce Hall doors on the manse side of the building which make closing this door even more challenging. Please use extra care to make sure the doors are completely closed so you cannot pull/push them open. We've recently had incidents on both sets of lockable doors into Pierce Hall not being closed properly. This should be done for the safety of individuals using our facility.

At this time of year, we as a church do a little extra giving for the community. Please read the notices about the food pantry and angle tree giving.
